



## **RPX featured at National Food Aid Conference**

### *Ecuador feeding program highlighted*

A video documentary of a unique feeding program managed by the Resource and Policy Exchange (RPX) in South America was featured at the annual US Food Aid Conference in Kansas City. The three-minute video, which was designed for internet broadcast on the RPX website, demonstrates the positive impact of carefully placed food aid and highlights the importance of working with local organizations.

“We were happy that the Ecuador piece could be used as an example and to educate”, said filmmaker Andy Bergmann, who produced and directed the film for RPX.

The US Agency for International Development (USAID) presented the film to representatives from US nonprofits, food producers and the International shipping community as an illustration of the International Food Relief Partnership (IFRP) program. Under the IFRP program, USAID’s Office of Food for Peace partners with nonprofit food producer, Breedlove Dehydrated Foods of Lubbock TX, and nonprofit organizations from throughout the US to deliver food aid to over twenty developing countries.

RPX was founded as a nonprofit organization in 2003 to equalize standards of health care, information access and participation in government around the world. RPX addresses its mission by providing material and technical support to other nonprofit organizations in developing regions.
